FINAL DETAILS

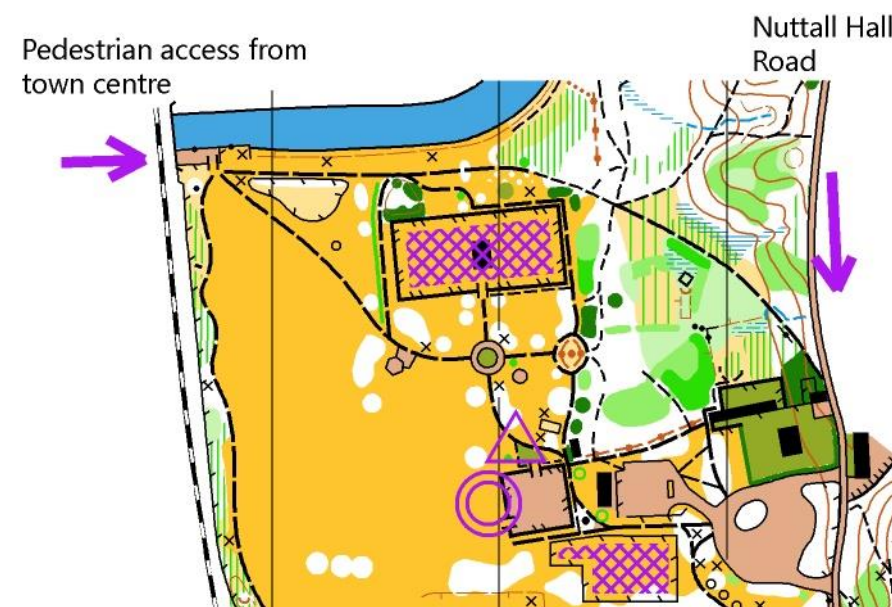
LOCATION Nuttall Park, Nuttall Hall Road, Ramsbottom, BL0 9LU. Grid Ref. SD 795 164

O signed into Nuttall Hall Road from Bury New Road, approx 800m east of town centre.

PARKING There is a substantial car park at the end of Nuttall Hall Road but if this gets full then please return to Bury New Road and park on adjacent streets (Eliza Street or Maple Grove) with due respect to other road users and local residents. **You must not park on Nuttall Hall Road itself.**

You could also park in the town centre and walk down Railway Street, past the factory, under the railway bridge into the Park.



ENTRIES Due to Covid safe procedures you must have pre-entered via Fabian4. There will be no entry on the day allowed.

TERRAIN A mixture of formal parks, open grassland and mature woodland with many ruins and some dangerous crags which must not be crossed. Courses are planned so that Orange and Light Green competitors can move parallel to the crags or have viable routes to avoid them. Orange and Light Green may also encounter mountain bikers and should take great care particularly in the ruined areas where there is much scattered rock. If football matches are being played then you must not cross the pitches.

MAP 1:4,000 scale --- Last major update November 2019 and some minor changes May 2021.

COURSES YELLOW. 1.7km and 10m climb.

ORANGE. 2.7km and 35m climb.

LIGHT GREEN. 3.9km and 75m climb. This is a two part course printed back to back on one sheet of paper.

We will not be providing loose descriptions sheets at the start but the Light Green descriptions are attached to these details if you wish to print off your own copy.

FACILITIES The Nuttall Park Base which is on the west edge of the car park will be open for takeaway drinks and snacks. Toilets are situated on the south end of the Base building.

START Will be 60m from the west end of the car park. Please, stay in your vehicles until approximately 10 minutes before your start time. Yellow course maps will be available in the pre-start area along with hired SI dibbers which will be in an envelope clearly showing your name and start time block. Clear and Check boxes will be on stakes whilst you are queuing.

Keep at least 2m away from everyone, follow the signs and verbal instructions from the Start officials and use the hand sanitisers provided if you need to.

At your allocated start time you will cross the line, punch to start then Orange and Light Green competitors will pick up their maps.

FINISH This is also adjacent to the Start. Hand sanitiser will be available here but you must move away, towards Download, to clear the area for other competitors coming in.

DOWNLOAD Will be approximately 20m from the Finish. More hand sanitiser will be here. If there is a queue please maintain your distancing. Please return immediately to your vehicles and having enjoyed your run, go home.

FIRST AID Will be adjacent to Download.

You must not attend this event if you are showing any signs of a Covid 19 infection, Self Isolating or if someone in your household or bubble is infected or self isolating and must follow the British Orienteering Code of Conduct relating to Covid precautions on returning to Orienteering.
